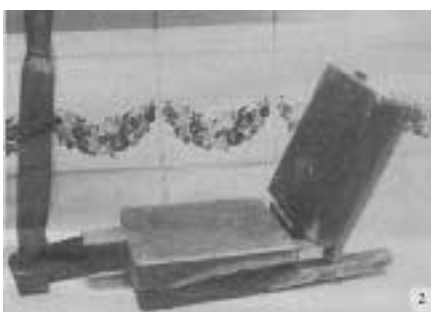


Kitchen Trivia
