


Curved Corners



Steel cornerbead offers softer look. The Bullnose cornerbead can be screwed, nailed, or glued to sections of drywall meeting at a corner to create a rounded look. The 7/8-inch flanges are then mudded over with regular joint compound, and the entire piece can be finished like the drywall, with paint or vinyl. The product is available in two sizes (standard ¾-inch radius, 90 degrees; and off-angle splayed bullnose, 135 degrees) and five lengths (from 6 to 10 feet). 
Handles With Care

Keeps You in Line





How Wet Is It?



With this humidity tester, you can find out. The Environmental Humidity Sampler is simple: a tube with a nontoxic, moisture-absorbing material packed into the closed end. It was developed by BLP, an engineering

firm that needed it for its own work. Users (mostly researchers in the indoor air quality and energy fields) hang the tube in the area being measured, take the cap off, and mark the time. A week later, they recap the tube, mark the time, and send the sample back to BLP, who will analyze the samples. For really accurate results, several tubes are used in different locations. The tester is used to simply test for humidity, or for calibration purposes when other detectors that are humiditysensitive - such as formaldehyde monitors—are being used.
