# **Outdoor Vinyl Flooring**

This chemical-resistant, fabric-reinforced vinyl membrane provides a durable nonskid, fire-resistant, waterproof surface for many outdoor or indoor applications, including roof and pool decks, garages, balconies, gym and equipment rooms, and wheelchair ramps. Duradek comes in a variety of colors,

patterns, and textures, and requires no regular maintenance beyond cleaning. The material can be applied over nearly any solid subsurface, and installs quickly in nearly any weather conditions. Minimal prep work is required because the membrane moves independently, bridging small cracks and expanding and contracting with the substrate. The material can be walked on even during installation, which is performed by trained subcon-



tractors for between \$5 and \$8.50 per square foot.

#### Truck Bed

f your pickup bed just isn't enough truck, consider remodeling it with the *Redi-Dek* steel platform body. Available in 8-, 9-, 10-, and 12-foot lengths, the 855/8-inch or 955/8-inch-wide body has outside 2x4 stake pockets, 1/4x2-inch tiedown rails, and a 1/8-inch steel plate floor immersion-primed for rust resistance. This 26-gauge zinc-aluminum coated steel panel is designed to look like red tile, but it only weighs 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> pounds per square foot. *Spanish Red Tile* roof panels are part of a line of metal roofing products that features easy installation and 230-mph wind resistance. Available in 3-foot widths and standard lengths of 2 to 20 feet, along with custom-sheared lengths, average cost is about


\$170 to \$200 per square, not including labor.



## **Wide Decking**

with the same loadbearing capacity as 6-inch deck boards, this 12-inch-wide PVC deck board can be ripped or custom cut around posts without sacrificing strength. The wider *Sheerline PVC Decking System* is also useful for outdoor stairs and steps because only one board per tread is needed. The UV-stabilized, high-impact, one-piece profile is said to be squeak-free, 50% stronger than two-piece systems, and more durable than wood. Available in beige, white, or gray, this maintenance-free material features a slip-resistant surface, and comes with all finishing parts needed for about \$4.60 per square foot.

Looking for a more durable alternative to conventional hydronic baseboard? The *UF-2* baseboard unit uses 20-gauge welded-steel panels instead of fintubes with steel covers, so the entire unit conducts heat from the hot water. Finished with a factory-applied acrylic enamel, the 6-inch-



high model has an output of 600 Btuh per ft. at 180°F. The list price for the UF-2 is about \$45 a foot; other sizes are available.

# **Rooftop Snow Fence**
