tyle Solutions has made the installation of crown molding much easier with the addition of preformed corners to its line of urethane molding. The pieces can be used with ten of the manufacturer's most popular crown molding profiles. Glue is applied to the urethane pieces, which are then fastened similarly to wood moldings. According to Style Solutions, the installation time is cut dramatically because the installer doesn't have to cut miters to form corners. List price is \$18 for both inside and outside corners; the crown starts at \$5.50

per lineal foot.
