
See-Through Storm Panels

uring the busy hurricane season of 2004, many people left their storm shutters in place for weeks, effectively turning their homes into caves. That is unless they used ClearGuard storm panels. Because these corrugated polycarbonate panels are transparent, they won't block the sunlight. The panels come in widths of 6, 12, and 14.5 inches, and in six standard lengths to match the most common window sizes. The company's dealer

network will also make custom sizes or sell the builder 20-foot lengths that can be cut to size on the job site. The panels can be fastened directly to the house or mounted on metal tracks. The company says that although the panels are only 1/10 of an inch thick, they pass the same tests as an impact-resistant window: a hit from a 9-pound 2x4 going 34 mph. ometimes you really need a long, straight stick — such as when you're framing a chimney chase, a tall window wall, or a "no-hinge" balloon-framed gable end for wind-resistant structural strength. That's when you might want to reach for Versa-Stud laminated veneer lumber (LVL) studs from Boise Cascade. With double the bending strength and 20% more stiffness than

typical sawn lumber, Versa-Stud has no warp, no knots, and no wane. And it's environmentally friendly, according to Boise — made from wood certified by the Sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI), with a process that utilizes the whole log, not just the heartwood. (a charger is included in the basic kit, and you can also get an optional automotive charger). Nails are paper-tape collated, so they won't throw tiny bits of wire in your eye — but even so, the kit includes safety glasses. 
