Straw Doors, Masonite says its new Safe 'N Sound Interior Doors are milled from a low-density fiberboard (called DorCor) that uses renewable wheat straw as its primary raw material. The units contain only low-emission adhesives and sealants and no urea-formaldehyde, the company says. Though lighter than conventional particleboard panels, they are billed as more effective sound-deadeners. A stocksize door panel costs about \$65; special-order sizes go for about \$90.

Noninvasive Wiring. FlatWire is a paper-thin copper wire approved for use in low-voltage lighting, audio, video, voice, and data applications. It can be fastened directly onto the surface of a wall or ceiling (with spray adhesive) and painted, or it can



be covered with tape and joint compound. It can also run underneath laminate flooring. (The maker is currently pursuing approval for a FlatWire product that can be used in standard 120-volt electrical wiring applications.) Pricing starts at \$2 per foot. Various connectors are also available.

Miele's stainless steel Telescopic Downdraft Hood tucks away beneath the countertop until it's needed, at which point it pops up with the touch of button, topping out at 14 inches above the cooking surface. The four-speed fan includes a 15-minute delayed shutdown feature. The hood comes in 30-inch (DA 6480) and 36-inch (DA 6490) sizes with a 500-cfm or 1,000-cfm blower assembly. Prices range from \$1,700 to \$2,300.

Simplified Crown. Not everyone relishes the challenge of coping and mitering crown molding. If you just want to get the job done, consider Fypon's *Miterless Crown Moulding*. The company sells a variety of lightweight one-piece urethane moldings in lengths up to 16 feet, as well as premitered inside and outside corner pieces and divider blocks that eliminate the need for scarf joints. Moldings run about \$6 per lineal foot; inside and outside corners cost about \$13 per piece.

No-Mess Tile. Adhesive tile mats — self-adhesive sheets with peel-off liners on both sides — allow you to fasten tile to surfaces without dipping a trowel in a bucket of glue. Its maker says *TileQu!ck Adhesive Membrane* creates an instant bond so that installers can grout immediately. The product is suitable for wall and counter tiles as large as 8 inches square. (It's not intended for shower stalls.) A 15-square-foot roll (18 inches by 10 feet) costs \$60.
