Tool-Op Vacuum Retrofit. Thanks to the RRP law, it's easy to find a decent HEPA vac for a reasonable price, but few have a tool-operated feature. ToolSync is a simple two-cord workaround. You insert the Vacpod cord between the vacuum and the power supply, and the Toolpod cord between the tool and its power source. A wireless connection between the two cords starts the vac whenever the tool is switched on. Because the two cords can be plugged into different circuits, ToolSync also minimizes the chance of blown fuses or tripped breakers. It

Swanson probably had aging baby boomers in mind when it devised the Lightening Level, but anyone who has to work in low-light conditions should appreciate the tool's very visible benefits. Even in total darkness, the LED-powered acrylic block vials are easy to read, says the company. The level is powered by two triple-A batteries and has an auto-shutoff feature to maximize battery life. It's sold with or without a magnetic edge, in 24-inch and 48-inch lengths; the 24-incher costs \$45.
